We hope you enjoy the festival.

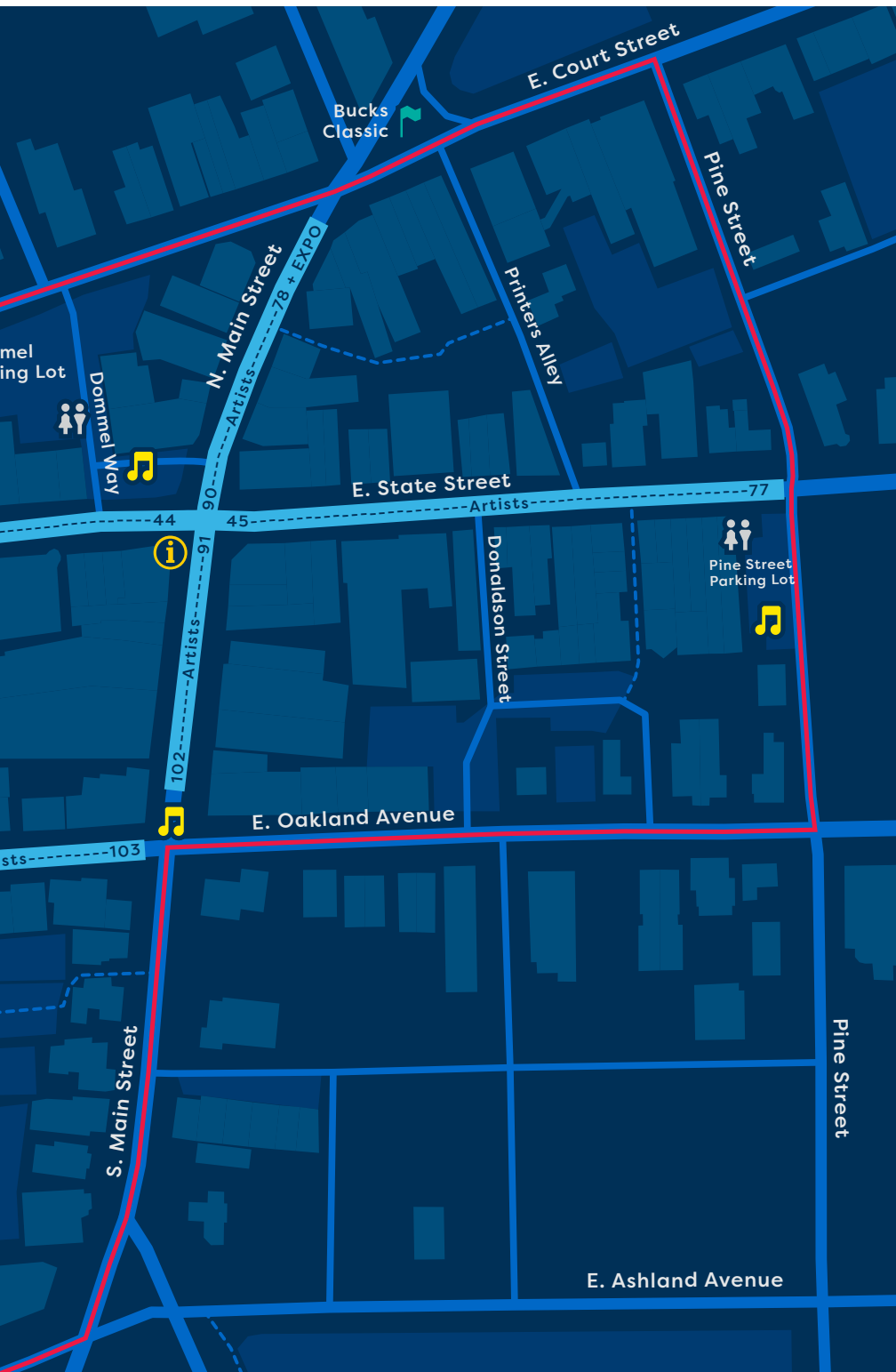
